

HASKELL CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

September 14 , 2020

The regular meeting of the Haskell City Council was held at 7:00 p.m. at the Haskell City Hall on Monday September 14, 2020.

Mayor Roy Carman called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Mayor Roy Carman led the Pledge of Allegiance; prayer was given by Jeff Harrison.

1. **WATER/SEWER:** Report was given by Public Works Director Casey Caudle, a copy of which is filed with these minutes.
 - W/S dept has fixed 6 leaks
 - Inside of water tower (stand pipe) has been completed. Outside of tank to begin this week.

 - Currently working on a drainage issue in Timberlake after having dug a ditch to help with water run-off.
 - Installed a new culvert on Hunters Run.
