

HASKELL CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

February 8, 2021

The regular meeting of the Haskell City Council was held at 7:00 p.m. at the Haskell City Hall on Monday February 8 , 2021.

Mayor Roy Carman called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Mayor Roy Carman led the Pledge of Allegiance; prayer was given by Jeff Harrison.

Jeff Harrison made the motion to accept the January 11, 2021 meeting minutes. Jacob Warner seconded motion. Motion passed unanimously by yea vote.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS:

1. WATER/SEWER

- The report was given by Mayor Roy Carman, a copy of which is filed with these minutes.
- We are currently working to applying for a CDBG Grant for the water line on Grand.

2. STREETS

- We are applying for yearly Street Aid money
- Street signs are being replaced.

3. FIRE & RESCUE

- The report was given by Fire Chief Brian Cotten, a copy of which is filed with these minutes.
- There was a fire at the Fire Station #1 in a closet that is being handled by the insurance company. Our current policy only insures up to \$9,000.00 for equipment, so Brian is looking into increasing that value.

- An estimate of \$3200.00 has been quoted for an alarm system at the Fire Station. They will quote a price for adding City Hall and the Police Department.

- Brad Cotten made a motion to approve Resolution 04-2021. Warren Kuhn seconded motion. Roll call vote was taken. Motion passed unanimously by yea vote.

3. Resolution 05-2021, Financing of Fire Truck

- Fire Chief Brian Cotten spoke on behalf of financing a new ladder truck for the Fire Department. He presented the City Council with two options of purchasing fire truck (a copy of those options is attached to these minutes)
- After a discussion, Jeff Harrison made a motion to move forward with Option 2. Warren Kuhn seconded motion. Roll call vote was taken. Motion passed unanimously by yea vote.

- C/R/T Jennifer Hill read the heading of Resolution 05-2021, A Resolution to enter into an agreement with PNC Equipment for financing of a fire truck in the amount of \$875,680.00.
- Brad Cotten made a motion to approve Resolution 05-2021. Jeff Harrison seconded motion. Roll call vote was taken. Motion passed unanimously by yea vote.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Warren Kuhn mentioned that the new siding on the Fire Museum looks nice.
- Adam Ricketts would like to look into adding a fee for boring under our roads.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

- Ms. Emaline Stroud informed the Council that the Historic Museum is using the old street signs at the museum.
