

HASKELL CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

March 8, 2021

The regular meeting of the Haskell City Council was held at 7:00 p.m. at the Haskell City Hall on Monday March 8, 2021.

Mayor Roy Carman called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS:

1. WATER/SEWER

- The report was given by Public Works Director Casey Caudle, a copy of which is filed with these minutes.
- The Water department repaired 7 leaks and 2 main break leaks and completed 47 work orders.
- Public Works Director Casey Caudle addressed the Council with the possibility of adding a boring fee to bore under our City street. More information will be presented on this at a later time.

6. Discussion regarding letter from Mr. Bennett

- The superintendent of Harmony Grove school, Mr. Heath Bennett, sent the Mayor, Police Chief and City Council members a letter concerning the help of the Haskell Police Department regarding school traffic issues. (A copy of letter is attached to these minutes)
- After a lengthy discussion regarding the contents of the letter. Warren Kuhn made a motion for the Mayor and Police Chief to have a meeting with Mr. Bennett to

resolve any issues. Brad Cotten seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Motion passed 4/3. A meeting will be scheduled.
