-  Use fertilizer sparingly and sweep up driveways, sidewalks, and gutters
-  Never dump anything down storm drains or in streams
-  Vegetate bare spots in your yard
-  Compost your yard waste
-  Use least toxic pesticides, follow label directions, and learn how to prevent pest problems
-  Direct downspouts away from paved surfaces; consider a rain garden to capture runoff
-  Take your car to the car wash instead of washing it in the driveway or street
-  Check your car for leaks and recycle your motor oil
-  Pick up after your pets
-  Have your septic tank pumped and system inspected regularly
