

ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 2006

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO DISCHARGE A FIREARM IN THE CITY LIMITS OF HASKELL, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Section 1. It is the intention of the City Council of the City of Haskell, Arkansas to preserve the peace and quiet enjoyment of its citizens and to provide a safe environment in which to live.

Section 2. Discharging of firearms; It shall be unlawful for any person to fire or discharge any weapon, cannon, gun, rifle, pistol, or firearm of any description within the boundary of the city of Haskell, Arkansas, except for the protection of life and property.

Section 3. Other kinds of guns; It shall be a misdemeanor for any person to discharge any gas, air or spring type rifle, BB or pellet gun within the boundary of the city of Haskell, with the intent of striking a person, residence or of causing physical damage to personal or real property belonging thereto.

Section 4. Responsible adult; The parent(s) or persons having actual custody of such minor child or children shall be held liable for such acts of violation by their child or ward. Any parent, parents, legal guardians or other persons having control and custody of minor child or children and any persons in violation of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof be fined not more than Five hundred Dollars (\$500.00)

Section 5. All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6 If any portion of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 7 Emergency Clause; This Ordinance being necessary to protect the health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Haskell, shall become effective from and after its date of passage.
