March 18, 2021

The SPECIAL meeting of the Haskell City Council was held at 7:00 p.m. at the Haskell City Hall on Thursday March 18 , 2021.

Mayor Roy Carman called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Discussion between the City Council and the HGSD School Board regarding the traffic concerns on Cates Rd and at the crosswalks.
 - Mr. Bennett and the HGSD School Board addressed the City Council with concerns about traffic issues on Cates Rd and the crosswalks; They are seeking assistance from the Haskell Police Department. There is a 10-15 minute window in the mornings and afternoons that require extra assistance outside of the SRO.
 - After a lengthy discussion, Police Chief Mike Watson stated that the Haskell Police Department would do what they could to help with the traffic concerns.
 - Mr. Bennett and Chief Watson will meet and discuss the traffic patterns.
 - Both the City Council/Mayor/Police Chief and Mr. Bennett and the School Board agree to a working relationship between the two entities.

There being no further comments or questions, Warren Kuhn made the motion to adjourn. Rodney Lyman seconded motion. Motion to adjourn passed unanimously by yea vote. Meeting adjourned at 8:21 pm.
